

Canvass of Election for a Representative to
Congress - November 13th 1838

ELECTION RECORD "A"
1838 - - - 1843

At a meeting of the Board of Canvassers
of the County of Macomb holden at Mount
Clemens on Tuesday, the thirtieth day of
November in the year of our Lord one thousand
and eight hundred and thirty eight at
one o'clock in the afternoon, pursuant to
Law to Canvass and estimate the returns
from the several Townships in said County
for a Representative to the Congress of
the United States Minot J. Lane Esq
was appointed Chairman and Amos Dalby
Secretary, and on said Board being organ-
-ized, they proceeded to canvass and
estimate the said returns, and find the following
to be the true statement of said Canvass
and estimate, to wit: Isaac E. Gray received
seven hundred and four votes for the office
of Representative to the Congress of the
United States, and Hezekiah G. Wells
received six hundred and ten votes for
the same office, there being thirteen hun-
-dred and fourteen votes given -

Cavass of Elections for State Senators
Nov. 13th 1838

At a meeting of the Board of Can-
-vassers for the County of Macomb and
State of Michigan holden at the County
Clerks Office in said County on Tuesday
the thirteenth day of November A.D. 1838
Pursuant to law, to Cavass and estimate
the returns from the several Townships
in said County. Minot T. Lane Esq. was
Chosen Chairman, and upon the said Board
being organized they proceeded to cavass
and estimate the votes given for Senators
to the State Legislature, and upon compar-
-ing and estimating said returns, they
find that the whole number of votes given
was two thousand five hundred and eighty
five of which Jacob Summers received
for the office of Senator to the State Legis-
-lature six hundred and seventy seven
votes; Ebenezer B. Harrington received
for the same office six hundred and sev-
-enty one votes; Reuben R. Smith received
for the same office six hundred and
eleven votes; Ira Porter received for the
same office six hundred and twenty three
votes; Ebenezer Harrington received for
the same office one vote and R. R. Smith
received for the same office two votes.

Canvass of Elections for Representatives and
County Officers Nov. 13, 1858

At a meeting of the Board of Canvassers for the County of Macomb and State of Michigan holden at the Clerk's office in said County at Mt. Clemens on Tuesday the thirteenth day of November A.D. 1858 pursuant to Law to Canvass and Estimate the Returns from the Several Townships in said County for Representatives to the State Legislature and the Several County Officers Minor Lane was appointed Chairman and on said Board being organized they proceeded to canvass and estimate the said Returns and find the following to be the true Statement of said Canvass and estimate to wit: There were three thousand five hundred and ninety eight votes given for Representatives to the State Legislature; of these there were given for Isaac J. Grovier for Representative in the State Legislature six hundred and ninety three votes; for Samuel Axford was given for the same office six hundred and sixty one votes for Alexander Jackson, was given for the same office six hundred and seventy eight votes; for Richard Butler was given for the same office; five hundred and sixty five votes; for Henry B. Shetterly, was given for the same office five hundred and ninety votes; for Orson Archer was given for the same office five hundred and thirty six votes; for Minor S. Lane was given for the same office forty five votes; for William Spurnan was given for the same office three votes; for James L. Boyer was given

for the same office twenty five votes for
Alexander La was given for the same office
one vote for Salmon Tuttle was given for
the same office one vote, for J. J. Grover
was given for the same office one vote, for
Henry Matthews was given for the same office
one vote, for A. Backles was given for
the same office one vote, for Mrs. Lane
was given for the same office one vote for
R. Butts was given for the same office one
vote. for J. Grover was given for the same
office one vote, for Rich D. Butts was
given for the same office one vote - There
were given for the office of Sheriff one thousand
and three hundred and two votes of these there
were given for Calvin Davis for the office
of Sheriff seven hundred and six votes
for Orson Sheldon was given for the same
office five hundred and ninety five votes
for Henry M. Dodge was given for the same
office one vote for the office of County
Commissioner, there were given three thousand
and nine hundred and ninety four votes
of these were given for Sampson H. Corbin for
the office of County Commissioner six hundred
and ninety two votes for Ephraim Perkins
was given for the same office, seven hundred
and twenty votes, for Solomon Porter was given
for the same office six hundred and seventy
three votes, for Ebenezer Hall was given for the
same office five hundred and eighty two votes
for Payson St. Leach was given for the same
office six hundred and eleven votes for Azariah
W. Sterling was given for the same office six
hundred and thirteen votes for Zachariah
Sterling was given for the same office one

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vote for Capt. Backler was given for
the same office one vote, for Rich^d & Batten
was given for the same office one vote.
for Eph. Balkin was given for the same
office one vote then were given for the
office of Register of Deeds one thousand
three hundred and five votes of these
were given for Thomas R. Bourne for the office
of Register of Deeds five hundred and eighty
five votes, for Amos Dalby for the same
office was given seven hundred and nineteen
votes, for A. Dalby for the same office one
vote, then were given for the office of
County Clerk one thousand three hundred and
three votes of these for the office of County
Clerk Amos Dalby received seven hundred
and fifty five votes, Calvin S. Williams
received for the same office five hundred
and fifty seven votes. A. Dalby received for
the same office one vote. then were given
for the office of Coroner two thousand five
hundred and eighty six votes, of these for
the office of Coroner were given for William
Lewis six hundred and ninety six votes, for
Alfred Goodell for the same office was
given six hundred and eighty nine votes,
for Isaac Russ was given for the same
office five hundred and ninety eight votes,
for Linus S. Gilbert was given for the
same office six hundred and one votes,
for Mr. Lewis was given for the same office one
vote, for Ebenezer Shaw was given for the same
office one vote, for the office of County Surveyor
then were given one thousand two hundred
and sixty six votes, of these Joel W. Mantley
received for the office of County Surveyor

Seven hundred and eighty five votes, for
Oren Southwell was given for the same
office four hundred and eighty votes,
for J. W. Manly was given for the same
office two votes, For the office of County
Treasurer there were given one thousand
three hundred and nine votes for the
office of County Treasurer Henry M. Dodge
received six hundred and eighty nine votes,
for Norman Perry was given for the
same office six hundred and two votes,
for H. M. Dodge for the same office was
given one vote,
