Dear Ms. Sabaugh,

I am submitting the enclosed plan for redistricting the County Commissioner Districts based on the 2010 Decennial Census. The proposed plan follows the criteria pertaining to apportionment of County Commission Districts as set forth in Section 5.1, Article 4 of the Macomb County Charter. The targeted population for each District is 64,691, which is one thirteenth of the Macomb County 2010 Census population of 840,978.

The plan meets the specified guidelines. Of the 27 cities, villages, and townships in the county, 21 are wholly within one Commissioner District, and 5 governmental entities are split because their populations exceed the 64,691 threshold. The deviation factor for all 13 Districts range from 3.80 percent on the plus side to 3.96 percent on the minus side. Nine of the 13 Districts have a deviation factor below 2.20 percent. A table summarizing the deviation factor for each district is enclosed.

Additionally, the Districts are drawn without regard to partisan political advantage; are as contiguous, compact and square as possible; and do not split any election precinct. The plan takes into consideration the residency of each of the 13 incumbent Commissioners so as not to pit seated commissioners against one another. It also reflects the long-term trend that the south end of the county has been losing population the past 20 years, while the area north of M-59 has grown by over 90 percent during the same time- frame.

Also enclosed is a summary of the election precincts assigned to each District.

As to my credentials, I have both an MA and BA in Geography and have worked as a Geographer virtually my entire professional career, expanding nearly 40 years. I have served as Assistant Planner with the

Macomb County Planning Department; Principal Research Analyst and Head Planner of the Regional Planning Commission (now SEMCOG); then 26 years with the Census Bureau, retiring as Assistant Chief of Operations with the Geography Division.

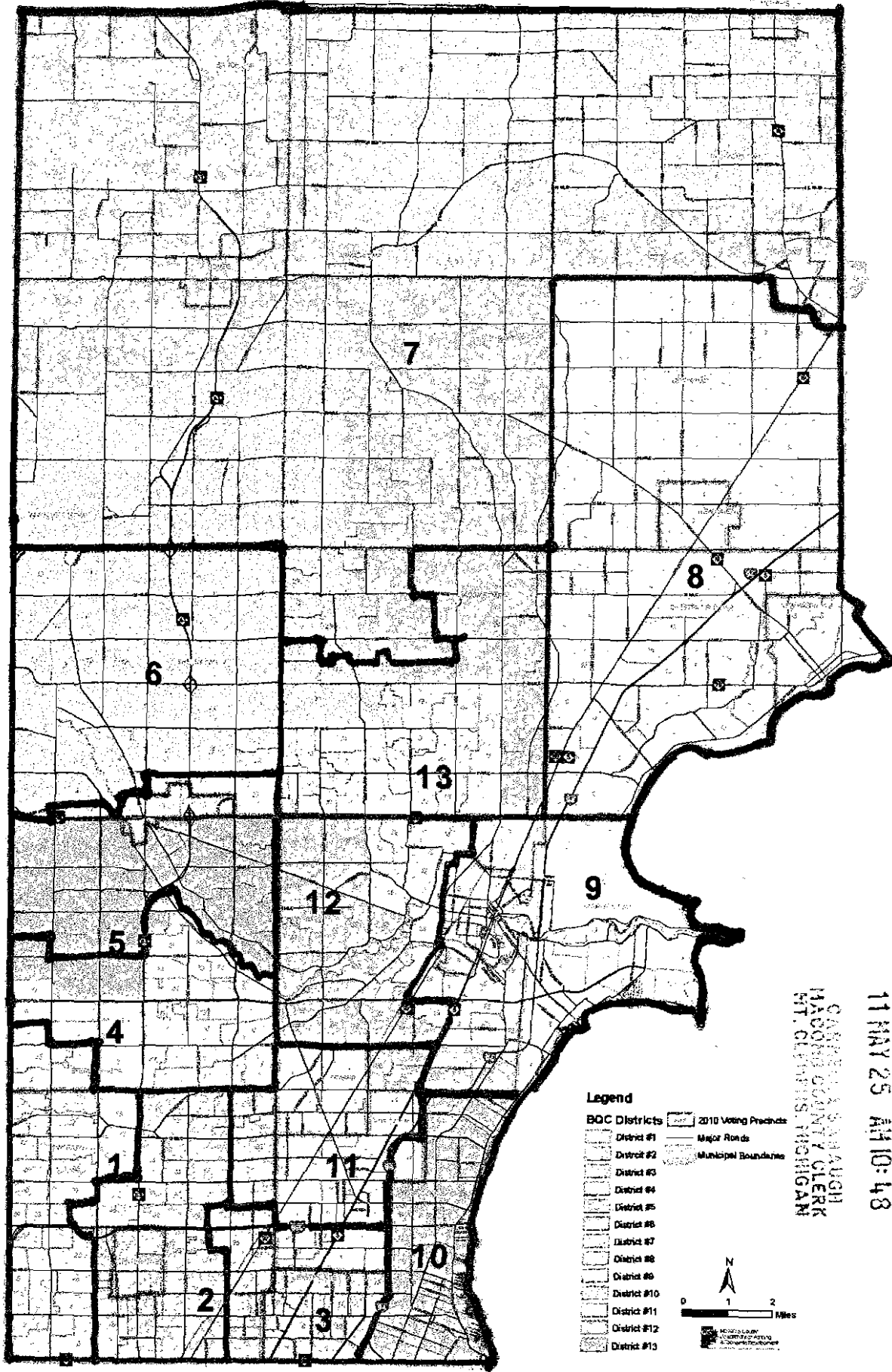

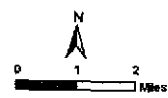
