BACKGROUND:

The Macomb County Clerk/Register of Deeds creates the official directory for Macomb County. It includes a comprehensive list of county and local government officials, offices and services, including addresses, phone numbers and Internet addresses. A new version is available online each year. Prior to 2008, the directory was printed and distributed to the community. No directory was printed in 2008 or 2009. A limited number of copies of the 2010 directory was printed and sold to the public to cover the costs. If printed, the directory would be available to the public and to all elected officials for distribution. Due to the number of changes that have taken place in 2011, including the new form of government, the clerk/register of deeds feels printing of directory is necessary.

The Purchasing Department sent out and received sealed bids, which were read aloud publicly in the Purchasing Department at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 3, 2011, with results for 35,000 directories as follows:

Subject: Independent Audit

Section 8.3.1 of the Macomb County Charter states in part "The Executive, with the consent of the Audit Committee, shall hire an independent certified public accountant to conduct an annual independent audit as required by law."

The County's most recent fiscal period ended on December 31, 2010. State Treasury regulations mandate that our 2010 annual audit be filed in Lansing by June 30, 2011.

The County Board of Commissioners previously engaged the firm Rehmann Robson to perform annual County audits for the five year audit period ending in 2011. Rehmann Robson was the low bidder when awarded their five year contract in 2007 by the Board of Commissioners. I have been advised that Rehmann Robson has performed their work in an exemplary manner in completing the 2007, 2008 and 2009 audits.

Based on the above and with your concurrence, I am recommending that we engage the firm Rehmann Robson to perform the County's 2010 independent audit.

**FULL FAITH AND CREDIT RESOLUTION
8 ½ MILE RELIEF DRAIN DRAINAGE DISTRICT BONDS (SERIES 2011A)
(LIMITED TAX GENERAL OBLIGATION)
AND ASSUMPTION OF COSTS OF DRAIN**

WHEREAS, Chapter 20 of Act 40, Public Acts of Michigan, 1956, as amended (the "Drain Code"), authorizes any county to pledge its full faith and credit for the payment of obligations issued thereunder, if the county board of commissioners has adopted a resolution by two-thirds (2/3) vote of its members-elect to that effect; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to petitions filed by the City of Eastpointe and the City of St. Clair Shores, each of Macomb County, Michigan (collectively, the "Communities"), pursuant to Chapter 20 of the Drain Code, with the Public Works Commissioner of the County of Macomb, proceedings have been carried out by the Intra-County Drainage Board for the 8 ½ Mile Relief Drain Drainage District (the "Issuer") for the financing and construction of certain intra-county drainage projects, said projects having been determined to be necessary for the public health; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authorization provided in the Drain Code, the Drainage Board of the Issuer expects to provide for the issuance of one or more series of bonds to finance costs relating to the project described on Schedule I (the "Project"), and the costs of issuance of such bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Drainage Board of the Issuer has or will authorize and provide for the issuance by the Issuer of its bonds to be sold to the Michigan Finance Authority (the "Authority") under its State Revolving Fund Program, to be designated 8 ½ Mile Relief Drain Drainage District Bonds (Series 2011A) (Limited Tax General Obligation) (the "Series 2011A Bonds"), with such modifications and other designations as may be approved by resolution of the Drainage Board, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$800,000, with such bonds expected to be issued by approximately the first quarter of 2011, bearing interest at the rates and maturing in such amounts and at such times as to be set forth in the resolutions of the Drainage Board; and

WHEREAS, such Series 2011A Bonds will be payable from the collection of special assessments against the Communities, and any other parties assessed under the applicable provisions of the Drain Code, to be paid in installments; and

WHEREAS, said drainage projects are immediately necessary to protect and preserve the public health, and it is in the best interest of the Communities and the County of Macomb that the Series 2011A Bonds be secured by a pledge of the full faith and credit of the County, as authorized by the provisions of said Drain Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MACOMB, MICHIGAN:

1. That pursuant to the authorization provided in the Drain Code, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Macomb, by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of its members-elect, does hereby irrevocably pledge the full faith and credit of the County of Macomb for the prompt payment of the principal of and interest on the Series 2011A Bonds when due, and pursuant to said pledge, in the event that the aforesaid Drainage District shall fail or neglect to pay the Series 2011A Bonds or interest thereon when due, the amount unpaid shall be promptly advanced from county funds as a first budget obligation, and the County Treasurer is directed to immediately make such advancement to the extent necessary.

2. That in the event that pursuant to said pledge of its full faith and credit the County of Macomb advances out of County funds all or any part of said installments and interest, it shall be the duty of the County Treasurer, for and on behalf of the County of Macomb, to take all actions and proceedings and pursue all remedies permitted or authorized by law for the reimbursement of such sums so paid.

3. That the County Executive, the County Treasurer of the County of Macomb, the Public Works Commissioner, and any other official of the County of Macomb, and their respective designees, or any of them, are authorized and directed to take all necessary legal procedures and steps necessary or desirable, for and on behalf of the County of Macomb, in connection with the authorization, sale and delivery of the aforesaid Series 2011A Bonds, such legal procedures and steps to include, without limitation, (a) the right of the County of Macomb to file a qualifying statement, request for reconsideration, or application for state treasurer's approval to issue long-term securities, as applicable, with the Michigan Department of Treasury pursuant to Act 34, Public Acts of Michigan, 2001, as amended, and to pay any related fees in connection with any of the foregoing, and to take any other actions necessary or desirable under said Act, (b) including financial and operating information concerning the County of Macomb in any preliminary or final official statement relating to such bonds and approving the circulation of a preliminary or final official statement relating to such bonds, and (c) executing and delivering a continuing disclosure certificate and any amendments thereto in accordance with the requirements of Rule 15c2-12 the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and such other certificates, documents and instruments as may be required by the purchaser(s) of the bonds. To the extent a continuing disclosure certificate is executed and delivered, the County of Macomb hereby covenants and agrees that it will comply with and carry out all of the provisions of such continuing disclosure certificate. The remedies for any failure of the County of Macomb to comply with and carry out the provisions of the continuing disclosure certificate shall be as set forth therein.

4. That pursuant to the authorization provided in Sections 468 and 488 of the Drain Code, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Macomb does hereby approve the County's assumption of 4.49975% of the costs of the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$39,980. Such costs shall be assessed against the County.

5. That all resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution be and the same hereby are rescinded.

Energy improvements at the Chapaton Pump Station, including replacing windows and one external door, replacement of the existing boiler, installation of infrared heaters, replacement of light fixtures, installation of a make-up air unit, and installation of a photovoltaic panel system.

SUBJECT: Purchase of Prior Governmental Service Time

DATE: December 16, 2010

The Macomb County Board of Commissioners adopted new policies regarding the purchase of prior government service. Based on your County service to date of 12 years, your purchase of other government time is limited to the lower of your time worked with the other governmental unit or 36 months. You have previously purchased 22 months. The cost of 14 months with Michigan Public School Employees Retirement System (MPSERS) is \$1,343 if purchased by January 31, 2011.

This letter does not constitute approval to purchase this time it is only for your information as to cost.

Should you wish to proceed with this purchase you must apply to and receive permission from the Macomb County Board of Commissioners. The Board of Commissioners will determine your eligibility by an affirmative vote of not less than three-fifth of its members.

After the Macomb County Board of Commissioners acts on your request and prior to your purchase of the requested credit, you will be required to provide written proof that you have received a refund of your contributions and forfeited all pension rights (including your rights under the Reciprocal Retirement Act) with the State of Michigan.

You are also advised that in the event your bargaining unit has the Annuity Withdrawal privilege on retirement, the purchase amount of the above time will not qualify. Annuity Withdrawal is available only for those sums contributed pursuant to the Macomb County Employees Retirement System retirement deductions.

If you wish to request permission to purchase the above noted other government time please address a letter to the undersigned.
