Additional Background Information (If Needed):

The attached lease agreement with Mount Clemens Community Schools (MCCS) will allow Macomb County Community Services Agency (MCCSA) to utilize space in George Washington Elementary School for at least five Head Start and Early Head Start classrooms as an anchor program. Other Macomb County programs and community partners will also be co-located in the building to create the County's second Family Resource Center.

Addressing the needs of pre-school aged children and their families is a priority for MCCSA. As we continue to seek solutions for families that address both the causes and symptoms of poverty in Macomb County, we embrace the opportunity to lease a building from MCCS that further embeds resources in communities with demonstrated need.

The Parties have reached a tentative settlement on a 2016 Wage Re-Opener and agree to amend the January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2016 Collective Bargaining Agreement as follows:

Lump Sum Payment: The previously agreed to lump sum payment of \$500 to be paid each full-time employee, including DROP participants, on the first regular paycheck in 2016 is eliminated and will not be paid as a result of this amendment. The POLC - Captains/Jail Administrator/Chief of Staff unit to receive a \$2,750 lump sum payment.
