2024 FILING REQUIREMENTS FOR MACOMB COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Two 6-year terms ending 12/31/2030

WHERE TO FILE

Macomb Community College Board of Trustees candidates must file with the Macomb County Clerk's Office, Elections Department, which is located at 32 Market Street, Mount Clemens.

WHAT TO FILE

- > Affidavit of Identity and Receipt of Filing, in duplicate.
- Community College Nominating Petitions containing a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 100 signatures from qualified and registered electors in the Macomb Community College District **OR** a \$100.00 nonrefundable filing fee, in lieu of nominating petitions.

All candidates must submit an Affidavit of Identity, in duplicate, when filing for office. Under Public Act 394 of 1984, a candidate who fails to file an Affidavit of Identity as required cannot be placed on the ballot. MCL 168.558 requires any candidate filing an Affidavit of Identity to state on the form that at the date the affidavit was executed all statements, reports, late filing fees, and fines required of the candidate or any candidate committee organized to support the candidate's election under the Michigan Campaign Finance Act have been filed or paid. Therefore, a candidate may not have any outstanding notices of failure to file or late fees with any filing official in the state.

WHEN TO FILE

Candidates must file no later than 4:00 p.m. on July 23, 2024.

CANDIDATE WITHDRAWAL

Candidates must withdraw, in writing, with the filing official by 4:00 p.m. on July 26, 2024.

CAMPAIGN FINANCE

All candidates are required to comply with the Campaign Finance Act filing requirements. Information is available in our office Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

MCC BOARD OF TRUSTEES QUALIFICATIONS

Must be a citizen of the United States and a qualified and registered elector of the district by the filing deadline.
