Present Frankott Lingenhausen - J. H. Nims Arthur C. Van Eps and Miles W. Davis. Frankott Lingenhausen was elected Chairman and Miles W. Davis Secretary of the Board.

The Board then proceeded to tabulate and canvass the votes given at the general election held on 3rd day of April 1899 which follows on next page.

On Motion of Mr. Nims voted that copy of canvass be published in the Mt. Clemens Press and Rome Observer.

On Motion of Mr. Van Eps James S. Tucker was declared duly elected Circuit Judge for 16th Judicial Circuit for the term of 4 years and Robert J. Crawford was declared Circuit Court Commissioner of Schools for said County for the term of two years.
