Hon. J. A. Tucker was re-elected  
 Circuit Judge of Macomb County  
 at the election of April 2nd over  
 his Republican opponent, John  
 Weeks, by a total majority of 53  
 votes.

This fact became known at 5 o-  
 clock Thursday afternoon, follow-  
 ing the re-count by the state board  
 of canvassers, at Mr. Weeks' re-  
 quest. Secretary of State Coleman  
 Vaughn, acting as chairman, with  
 Deputy Attorney General Bailey,  
 formally notified Judge Tucker of  
 the board's findings at this hour.

The re-count developed numer-  
 ous errors in the various town-  
 ships and village board's counts,  
 the most pronounced, perhaps, be-  
 ing in the two precincts of Wash-  
 ington, as shown in the figure  
 compiled below. There were also  
 several errors in the three wards  
 of the city.

The following gives the two  
 counts; the first column of figures  
 under the name of the candidate  
 represents the findings of the town  
 boards, as reported to the county  
 board of canvassers. The second  
 column of figures, appearing un-  
 der the name of the candidate,  
 shows the final and conclusive  
 count, by the state board.
